

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) ELIGIBILITY BY STATE



More than 500,000 people in the United States have died after contracting the virus. About 43.6 million people have received at least one dose of a Covid-19 vaccine, including about 18.9 million people who have been fully vaccinated. **Vaccine shipments have been delayed and vaccination sites closed due to recent inclement weather throughout many portions of the U.S. Check with your local health department or provider regarding vaccine access and appointments.**
